

Acid Cleaner Concentrate

PRODUCT DESCRIPTION AND USES:

A general purpose acid cleaner which is a phosphoric acid solution containing solvents and surfactants which has many applications in cleaning and preparing substrates for subsequent coating. Typical uses are for the cleaning of steel, zinc and aluminium alloys. On steel surfaces light surface rust is dissolved and a tightly adherent phosphate coating is produced, which enhances the adhesion of coatings. It is also suitable for the treatment of new and old concrete floors etc prior to application of coatings. The acid, solvent and surfactant together produce a combined etching and degreasing action on the concrete surface.

PHYSICAL PROPERTIES:

Colour: Clear
Specific Gravity: 1.32 kg/litre

APPLICATION DATA:

Aluminium Surfaces: Apply liberally using cotton swab, clean rags or mop. Allow to remain in contact with the surface for about 10 minutes. **DO NOT LET THE SURFACE DRY.** Hose off thoroughly with clean fresh water. Abrasive pads or scourers may be used to remove heavy corrosion deposits. Treated surfaces should be painted as soon as possible after drying.

Metal Surfaces: Apply liberally using a cotton swab, clean rags or mop. Allow to remain in contact with the surface for 10 minutes, and then wipe off thoroughly with a clean cloth wetted with the diluted cleaner. If the treated surface dries out, re-apply cleaner before wiping off. Abrasive pads or scourers may be used to remove heavy corrosion deposits. Treated surfaces should be painted as soon as possible after drying.

Concrete Surfaces: Mix 1 part acid cleaner to 3 parts water. Apply liberally using a cotton swab or mop. After 10 minutes rinse thoroughly with clean tap water to remove all loose residues. Repeat treatment until surface is uniformly etched to a dull finish and is free from grease and oil. Allow to dry completely before coating.
